## Reporting a Case of Covid19 during the Christmas Break.

#### Arrangements for Thursday 17th (evening) December – Wednesday 23rd December

COVID test reporting procedures have been put in place within Cidari to allow contact tracing for a further six days following the end of the Autumn Term. This is to ensure that parents can report a positive coronavirus test result if their child develops symptoms within 48 hours of their last school day.

This will ensure that close contacts (staff and pupils) can be informed of the need to self-isolate to help prevent the spread of coronavirus within the community over the Christmas holidays.

For the first 6 days of school closure, please report a positive case of COVID19 one of the following ways:
