There is an expectation that each child will engage with some of the learning provided. If you need any support with any of the work set, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher.

These are uncertain and difficult times for us all, we will no doubt encounter problems with this new way of working and your understanding with any technical issues will be greatly appreciated.
