Dear Parents and Carers,

As a school, we have put together a remote learning package. For Reception children, play is still the most important way to learn. Throughout the day they should be given time to play either alone, or with an adult. Reading together, playing together and talking to each other remains the most effective way for young children to learn.

Each day there will be four zoom sessions where your child can access face to face learning with their class teacher. Alongside this, the children will be expected to complete independent tasks at home.

Independent tasks children should complete each day:

- One Phonics Task
- One Maths Task
- One Topic Task

These can be related to the face to face teaching sessions or you can choose which activity you want your child to complete each day. To access the face to face sessions parents will need to have access to Zoom. This can be used on any mobile device, laptop or tablet.
