Reporting a Case of Covid19 during the Half Term Break.

Arrangements for Friday 12th (evening) February - Wednesday 17th February

COVID test reporting procedures have been put in place within Cidari to allow contact tracing for a further five days following the end of school for half term. This is to ensure that parents of pupils who have been attending during lockdown can report a positive coronavirus test result if their child develops symptoms within 48 hours of their last school day. This will ensure that close contacts (staff and pupils) can be informed of the need to self-isolate to help prevent the spread of coronavirus within the community over half term.

For the first 5 days of the half term break please report a positive case of COVID19 one of the following ways: When you contact us please ensure you give us the following information.

- Your name and contact information
- Your child's full name & date of birth
- The Academy they attend & class
- The date they first had symptoms (if applicable)
- The day/ date that they were tested
- The day/ date they were last in school

After Wednesday 17th February, if a child tests positive for coronavirus, parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

Where pupils are required to self-isolate due to contact with a positive case following the end of term, we do not need to be informed about their absence until the first day of the new term. If your child has a place to attend after half term, future cases will be reported directly to the Academy through the usual contact details above.
