forth a child. *Best Wishes*

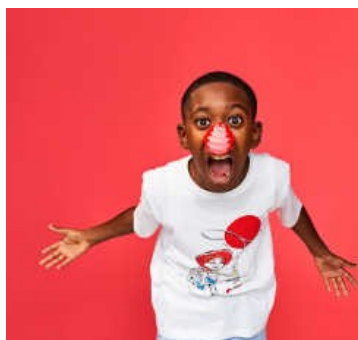
We ask You to bless all
