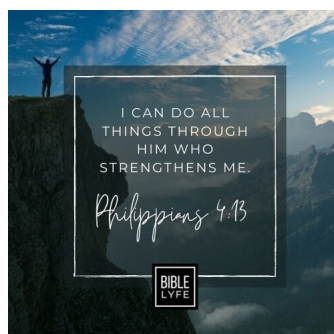
**Our Gospel Value this half term is ...**
