Dear Parents/Carers

**GCSE Results Day Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2020**

I am writing to let you know that due to the restrictions still in place for public gatherings, this year GCSE examination results will not be distributed to pupils at school in the usual way. Instead we will be releasing results on the morning Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August via Go 4 Schools. This is an online software package that the school uses to report pupil results and progress data, as you may remember from the distribution of Mock Exam results earlier in the academic year.

The results will be sent directly to your son/daughter. To view their results via this platform, they will firstly need to create a student account with Go 4 Schools.

In order to do this, they will need to make sure they can access their Waseley Hills School Email account, as this is where Go 4 Schools will send them a link for creating their Go 4 Schools password.

Attached to this letter are step by step instructions for your son/daughter to follow, in order to:

- 1) Log into their school email account
- 2) Set up a student account in Go 4 Schools

It is vital that both the school email account is accessible and a Go 4 Schools student account is successfully set up in the next two weeks, in preparation for receiving results on GCSE results day.

Before the end of term, we will check that all Year 11 students have successfully completed these two steps, and will send out reminders where this has not happened.


