Please note that we are happy to see parents but at present this can be by an appointment only which can be made by telephoning the school office. Often a phone call with either the Tutor or Head of Year is sufficient to address the problem and we will try to help you in this way first. If you have an appointment during the school day then please use the white doors on the left of reception and the bell/intercom where staff will be pleased to sign you in to school reception.

In addition access to the school site is very limited and parents are not allowed to park in the staff car park or on the main access road from the front gate that runs to the Holywell turning circle. We ask all parents to keep their cars off the school site unless attending an appointment and where parking is required it should be in the overflow car park which is situated on the right hand side at the end of the school access road. I'm sure that you'll understand that this is for the safety and security of all of our students.

Finally, please download and use the WEDUC communication tool on your phone or tablet device. It offers excellent access to school information and regular updates.
