Waseley Hills Year 7 Students – September 2020 Transition

I would just like to update you regarding the details of the year 6 transition at the present time:

- Currently we are unable to conduct a physical transition where groups of students are on the school site for transition activities as would typically happen without the covid-19 restrictions. If this situation changes where there is a relaxation of measures, and as a school we feel confident to safely provide some type of induction, then we will inform you as soon as possible. The new year 7s will have a day just for them in September without any other years in school.
- All pupils who have been identified as having special educational needs and/or vulnerable will be contacted over the coming days by a member of the SEND team to discuss any issues that you might have and answer any questions relating to the move to secondary school.
- The head of year 7 has started the process of conducting Zoom meetings with year 6 classes as an alternative to visiting the pupils at their primary school. This will continue with all major feeder primary schools in a format that is suitable for the respective establishment.
- Pupils will be allocated houses and form groups by the week beginning 06/07/2020. If your child has a sibling who attends WHHS then they will be placed in the same house.
- The transition page on the school website now contains English and Maths booklets for pupils to work through over the summer as a way of introducing some of the content that they will experience when in Year 7.
