



Year Nursery

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Me and My World	Children will study themselves and their immediate surroundings. Who am I? Who are my family? Who are my Friends? Where is my home?
Celebrations	Children will learn about different types of celebrations including birthdays, bonfire night, Halloween, harvest, Christmas. They will explore their own celebrations.
Bears	Children will look at teddy bears from the past to the present. They will learn about different materials and how things work. They will explore stories including bears including Goldilocks, where's my teddy to learn about environments. They will learn about the weather and clothes.
Come Outside	Children will learn about the environment around them. Through stories such as 'We're going on a bear hunt' and nursery rhymes 'Old Mc Donald they will explore different environments and what we might find in them. They will learn about different plants and how to grow them.
Amazing Animals	Children will learn about different animals. They will study pets and how to take care of them (link to vets), farm animals including animals that do jobs, and animals that they may find in a zoo. Children will share information about animals at home. They will explore the differences in animals and how we take care of them, knowing that not all animals are pets. (Link back to environments and life cycles)
Special People	Children will learn about people in the community who help them including at home and in school. They will explore important jobs such as teaching, police, nurse, but other important jobs such as shop assistants and bin collectors.



Year Reception

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Me and My World	<p>Children will begin to look at the communities that they belong to.</p> <p>Where is my school? Who is in my community? Where is my street? What is in my town? What was it like in the past?</p>
Festivals	<p>Children will learn about different festivals from around the world including, Diwali, Hanukkah, Eid ul Fitr Christmas.</p> <p>They will learn the different traditions, stories and cultures including food and dress.</p>
It's Cold Out There!	<p>Children will learn about the weather and begin to explore changing seasons. They will learn about animals that hibernate and that are nocturnal. Children will begin to explore different places that are cold including the Arctic and Antarctica and how these compare to where we live.</p>
Spring Into Life	<p>Children will learn about new life of animals and plants. They will learn about different life cycles and animals. Children will learn about the countryside and the animals/plants that they may find there and comparing these to animals they may find in other countries. Children will take a closer look at minibeasts. Children will learn about what we can grow. They will learn about Spring and how the season changes.</p>
Once upon a time	<p>Children will learn the stories of Kings and Queens understanding rich and poor. They will learn about homes from a long time ago and how time has changed. They will learn about geographical features of environments such as bridges and create maps to represent places. They will explore materials and understand how they are used.</p>
Amazing Adventures	<p>Children will begin to explore the wider world through different stories such as Handa's surprise. They will use their prior knowledge to compare contrasting settings and places around the world. They will look at different traditions and cultures including different food and clothes and the homes that people live in.</p> <p>They will look at different transports used on different adventures.</p>
