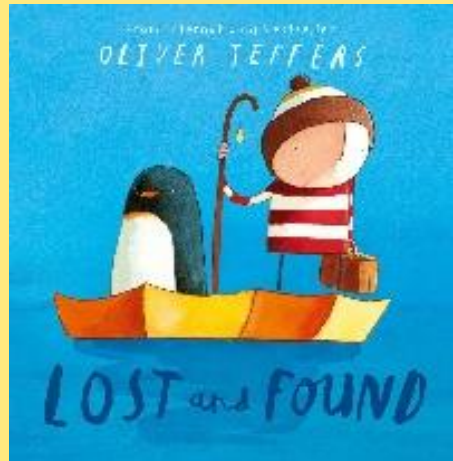


Curriculum Overview for Year 1

Spirals
