Dear Parents and Carers

This week, thanks to you and your wonderful children, we were able to donate £349 to Children in Need.

This, along with Save the Children, is a charity that is really close to our hearts as a primary school. Children in need currently supports over 3,000 local charities and projects in communities across the United Kingdom that are helping children and young people affected by poverty and deprivation.



At the time of writing, there are 4.2 million children in poverty across the UK and an estimated 44% of families in crisis.

Many of our own families are also feeling financial pressure or experiencing hardship as their circumstances post Covid-19 have changed. As a school we are aware that there are an increasing number of our families accessing local foodbanks and charities to support them in their time of need. Please remember that if your circumstances have changed significantly that you may be able to access additional support through the Pupil Premium and Free School Meal entitlement schemes. Our welfare team are here to support and can signpost you to a variety of local community support services. So please do not hesitate to let us know if you are aware of anyone in need. Your question or concern for either your own or another family will be treated in the strictest confidence and may be the helping hand that someone needs!
