



Whilst we are sympathetic to the disruption that has been caused during the earlier stages of the covid pandemic, the school remains unable to authorise any holiday absences. The unavoidable disruption to learning and learning behaviours – both academic and social – has been felt nationally with many children falling significantly behind in their learning. Whilst our families have worked tirelessly in partnership with the Waterside staff team to ensure that this impact on our children has been limited, we are still very conscious that we will all need to work in partnership to secure and embed learning for the new academic year.

Attendance Target: 97% or above

Whole school attendance this week was 95.4% a slight decrease from last academic week's 96%. This week the classes with the highest rate of attendance were the Ducks and the Seals both with 98.3%.
