The unavoidable disruption to learning and learning behaviours – both academic and social – has been felt nationally with many children falling significantly behind in their learning. Whilst our families have worked tirelessly in partnership with the Waterside staff team to ensure

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that this impact on our children has been limited, we are still very conscious that we will all need to continue to work very hard together to secure and embed the learning that our children will need to confidently apply in the new academic year.
