Understanding of the World

Activity 1

Draw a picture of you and your family. Can you name who everyone is? Describe your family. What body parts do they have. How are they all different?

Maths

Activity 2

Go on a hunt around your home and create sets of different objects. Can you create a set that is the same as your grown-up's? Check you all have the same 3 objects. For example, a car, a train and a plane or an apple, a drink and a chocolate bar.

Reading

Activity 3

Make a character from the Gruffalo using whichever materials and resources you like! You could use playdough, paint, crayons, cotton wool, paper, junk modelling anything! Take a picture and send it over!

Writing

Activity 4

Create a missing poster for the Gruffalo! Think about how you can describe him and include all his different body parts so we know what he looks like! You can ask an adult to help you by writing the word labels around the Gruffalo for people to read!

Activity 5

Set up a Garden Party for you and your toys. Can you make some pretend food using leaves, flowers and twigs. Add water to your ingredients to make some tea.

Activity 6

Ask an adult at home to take photos of different objects around the house. Then have a look at them either on the camera or printed off and see if you can go and find those objects to match to their picture. Can you find all the matches? How do you know they match?

Physical Development

Activity 7

Can you use blocks or a cardboard box to make a new home for the Gruffalo? What will you need? What features will his new home have?

Communication and Language

Activity 8

The Gruffalo lived in the woods with lots of other animals like a mouse, a fox, an owl and a snake. What creatures live near your house? Can you spot them and take a photo or draw a picture?
