I would like to remind you of the controls we have in school to keep everybody safe. The children are working in year group bubbles. They are constantly reminded to wash and sanitise their hands. Each child has their own resources to use so they are not sharing pencils, pens etc and their class rooms have been set out to allow for social distancing. I hope this reassures you of the precautions we are taking to keep everybody well.
