Dear Parents/Carers,

I am sure you are all aware of the rise in infection rates in our area and the new restrictions in place. I wanted to remind you of our plans to keep the children and adults safe when we welcome them back to school tomorrow.

How we can all help to keep your child safe.

We will reduce contact amongst children and adults as much as possible.

Your child will continue to work in a year group bubble.

They will stay in this classroom and year group area and movement around the school will be restricted.

Break times and lunchtimes will be staggered to ensure that your child will stay with this group to restrict mixing with other groups.

No equipment will be allowed in from home. Please only bring reading books into school on Friday for changing.

Make sure your child brings their packed lunches to school in the morning – we **cannot** receive packed lunches through the school office during the day.

PE kits must be brought into school on Monday and left in lockers until Friday. As the weather gets colder, please make sure your child has warm clothes in their PE kit.

Beginning and end of the school day.

It is really important that everybody sticks to their correct drop off and pick up time to avoid overcrowding on the playground.

If your children have different surnames please choose the time slot for the whole family and stick to this time.

Surnames beginning with:	A-F	G-L	M-R	S-Z
Start time.	8.40am	8.50am	9.00am	9.10am
Finish time.	2.45pm	2.55pm	3.05pm	3.15pm

You must use the allocated drop off and pick up point for each child.

Please observe the social distancing rules and do not gather to wait for other parents.

Parents will be allowed to bring their child onto the playground but please leave the school site as soon as the staff have collected them.

Where possible, only 1 person should drop off and collect the children, please do not bring older siblings or other family members onto the school site.

Please **do not** congregate outside the school gate or near the lollipop ladies.

Please note that the above information is still subject to change depending on Government guidance.
