Session 2

Discuss the children's ideas from the previous session. What animals do we have in our world? What do you know about this animal? (Record the children's ideas)

Session 4

What do you know about Chameleons? Recap on the front cover and discuss what it means if you get 'mixed up'. Read the first few pages of the story and discuss what the Chameleon likes to eat. Read up to where it says 'It was not very exciting. But one day ...' What do you think is going to happen next? Can you think of something that would be exciting for you?

Session 1

Recap on 'Here we are' and 'what a wonderful world' What can you tell me about our world? What makes our world so wonderful? Record the children's responses.

Session 5

What do we know about the chameleon? Look at the page at the zoo. Do you know any of these animals? Can you describe them? Record the children's ideas. Talk about what a zoo is and that we don't have these animals where we live and we would need to go to a zoo to see them.

Look at short video clips of the animals.

Continuous provision - small world zoo with labels, large animal outlines for painting and collaging.
