Read 'Tiny and Teeny' by Chris Judd and discuss the homes in the story and what the children's houses are like.

Read and sing 'Car, Car, truck, Jeep.' by Nick Sharett. Discuss the different vehicles in the story and which ones children know.

Music session using instruments and voices to sing the song and make different sounds for different vehicles.

Read 'Alphabet street' by Jonathan Emmett. Discuss the different shops and compare to those in the children's area.

I can play with small world toys like the dolls house and the vehicles and road mats and can name things like the rooms in my house and things I see on my way to school (e.g shop, cars, road)
