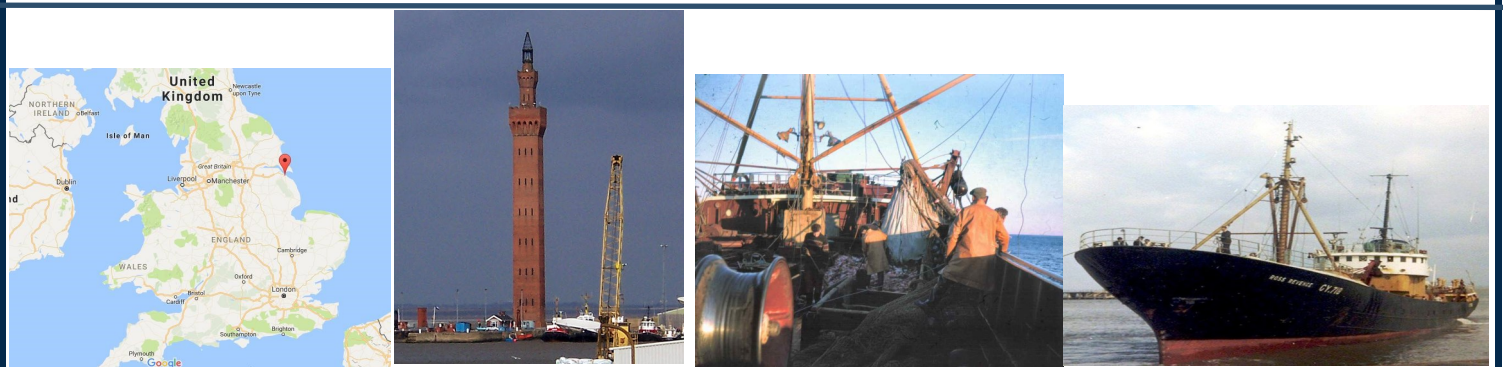
What will I know by the end of this topic?

Grimsby was a major sea port on the east coast of England, hosting the largest fishing fleet in the world by the mid-20th century.

According to legend, the name Grimsby derives from the name *Grim*, a Danish fisherman.
