

'Hands on History' Hull Visit

As part of our 'What makes Grimsby Great - The Victorians', we will be visiting The 'Hands on History' Museum in Hull to attend a Victorian school experience.

This will take place on **Thursday 17th October 2019**, leaving school at 9:00am and returning at 3:15pm.

The cost for this trip is £8.

Your child will need to be dressed in their school uniform, sensible footwear and a warm, waterproof coat. No pocket money will be required.

School Lunch

Your child will need to take a packed lunch and drink with them (NO GLASS BOTTLES, CHOCOLATE, SWEETS OR FIZZY DRINKS PLEASE).

For those of you who order your child's lunch online, we request that you select the sandwich option (which will always be a cheese bun) for this day and this will ensure your child will be provided with a school packed lunch on the day. If your child is having a school's packed lunch, they will need an additional drink.

For those of you who have already submitted your child's dinner choices, you will need to log back into the system and amend the day of the trip. Failure to do so will result in your child's school meal being cancelled and you will need to provide a packed lunch.

A rucksack / shoulder bag would be useful to carry their lunch in.

Please note: If your child needs an Asthma inhaler, he/she will not be allowed to take part in the visit unless they have it with them on the day.
