Dear Parents/Carers,

All schools are now legally required to provide remote learning to any child who needs to isolate due to Covid-19.

As you are aware, we did provide home learning during the lockdown period from March to July 2020. Many of you supported your child with this and we really appreciated this support. As a result of the new requirements, we have amended some of the systems we used in school last term to support children and families even more with remote learning.

In KS2 we will now be using **Microsoft Teams** to set homework if your child is isolating. Some classes are already using this with children in school. All children in KS2 have had a lesson to help them access the learning. We have also enclosed a leaflet explaining how to use Teams. I hope you find this useful. Foundation Stage and KS1 will continue to use Class Dojo for remote learning.

All classes will still have Class Dojo if you want to continue to communicate with your child's teacher.
