



# Year 4 Yorkshire Wildlife Park



Dear Parent/Carer,

We have arranged a visit to The Yorkshire Wildlife Park, Doncaster as part of our Power of Reading and linking to our topic work of "living things and their habitats".

This will take place on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March, leaving school at 9am and returning at the much later time of approx 4:45pm (we will send updates to our arrival time on the way back).

The cost per child will be £10 which should be paid online via your Parent Pay account or via Paypoint with your barcoded letter. The school has heavily subsidised this trip and if not enough £10 contributions are made it may have be cancelled.

Your child will need to be dressed warm in their own clothes (no jeans), sensible footwear and a warm, waterproof coat.

#### School Lunch

Your child will need to take a packed lunch and drink with them (NO GLASS BOTTLES, CHOCOLATE, SWEETS OR FIZZY DRINKS PLEASE).

For those of you who order your child's lunch online, we request that you select the sandwich option (which will always be a cheese bun) for this day and this will ensure your child will be provided with a school packed lunch on the day. If your child is having a school's packed lunch, they will need an additional drink.

A rucksack / shoulder bag would be useful to carry their lunch in.

No pocket money will be required for the trip.

**Please note:** If your child needs an Asthma inhaler, he/she will not be allowed to take part in the visit unless they have it with them on the day.
