Inevitably, the end of the school year does also often mean that we say goodbye to some colleagues. Mrs Jones, our part time teacher of MFL this year, will be moving to Tarleton Academy as Head of Foundation Faculty, and Mrs Walsh, who has taught Computing for one day a week since February, will move back to her role at Burscough Priory Academy. Mr Badin (Maths supply) and our three minibus drivers (Mr Harris, Mr Lumby & Mr Cottam) will also be leaving us this summer. Mr Evans, who joined us last year as Lead Practitioner of Maths, will also be moving into a new role at Penwortham Priory Academy. Finally, Mr Aindow, the Pastoral Behaviour Manager for Campbell house, will be finishing with us this year as his contract comes to an end.

I would like to thank every member of staff for their professionalism, hard work and dedication to providing the very best for all of our students. I am sure you will join me in wishing them well for the future.

You may have noticed that, within our new staff recruitment list above, I have appointed a new PA, Miss Duncan-Jameson. This is due to the retirement of my current PA, Mrs Swift.
