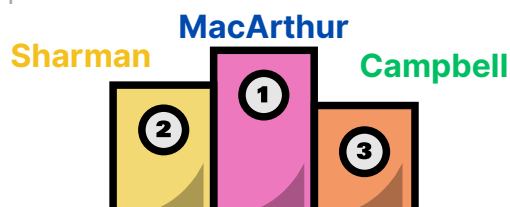
Important upcoming events
