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School Rebuilding Programme

After being confirmed as one of the 161 schools nationally to be involved in the School Rebuilding Programme, there is a lot of work ongoing in the background. This means we are currently within the feasibility stage of the project which involves a number of surveys and audits that have been completed to develop an in-depth understanding of the condition of our existing buildings.

Once the feasibility stage is completed, hopefully early in 2023, we should receive confirmation as to the scale of the project. Essentially, we should know whether the project will be a whole school replacement or block(s) to be replaced. We are really excited about the programme and look forward to writing to you in the new year once we have more information to share.

School Transport

We are aware of some issues recently with the 109 Chorley/Preston public bus which services the Euxton and Buckshaw Village areas. We are doing everything we can do from our school's perspective, including writing to the local councillor Aidy Riggott, who responded with a very supportive email which included an escalation of our/your concerns to the Cabinet Member for Education and Skills County Councillor Jayne Rear.

In the short term, we advise students use the 119 Chorley to Preston public bus which operates at multiple stops around Buckshaw Village and Euxton Lane alternatively there are Trains from Buckshaw Parkway to Leyland. We do have a small number of spaces on our school minibus transport which, you may recall, we could not expand further over the summer. Within the summer letter, I informed that we simply have too much demand for the number of spaces available and would not wish to disappoint/frustrate parents. If there are genuine safeguarding concerns regarding your child and/or they have additional needs, please contact us to consider whether a space can be given in the short term for these spaces. Again, if demand outweighs availability, we may have to direct you once again to the public transport. Hopefully you feel reassured that we are also trying to escalate our concerns where they matter.

Christmas Activities

The final three weeks of term will continue to see teachers delivering their full curriculum although there will be lots of Christmas activities mixed in. On Saturday, out PTFA have organised an amazing Christmas Fair in the sports hall. All students, families and members of the local community are more than welcome to attend from 11am onwards.

Following the fair, we look forward to the Mission Chrimpossible performances on Tuesday and Wednesday evening next week. So much hard work has been put into it so far and I am sure you will not be disappointed if you do come along!

Finally, we will enjoy Christmas Jumper Day and Christmas lunch on Thursday 15th December before we wrap up the term on Friday 16th (12.30pm) following a whole school assembly. More information will be provided over the next week or so about the final two days.
