COVID REMINDERS - It is crucial PLEASE that you continue to test using the lateral flow tests twice weekly at home for every pupil and also the rest of your family. Werneth School specific COVID updates:

- We have isolated a small group of Year 7 students this morning following a positive case. Remote learning will be activated and they will return on 12th July.
- We continue with **face coverings** for the immediate future. I have been asked again by the local authority to remind you that cases remain too high in Stockport in the age group 10-19. Positive cases remain well above national average across Greater Manchester, and you should take every precaution to prevent the transmission of the virus.
- Apologies for the confusion on Monday with regard to an out-of-date notice. As you heard, it was business as usual in school. To confirm, there are no INSET days until the end of term. We break up on Wednesday 21st July at midday.
- You will have heard all of the national coverage this week about removal of face coverings for the autumn term and hopefully no need for bubbles to be sent home from September. We really hope this is the case, and we are awaiting further guidance from the Department for Education. They are asking us to prepare for the possibility of on-site testing at the start of term. We will of course keep you updated with any developments.
- I will be sending out a **calendar for the new academic year** before the end of the term. Confirmation that our **new Year 7s and new Year 11s will start on Thursday 2nd September**, and **new Years 8, 9 and 10 will start on Friday 3rd September**.

All referred families will receive nutritionally balanced food parcels for up to five weeks.
