Express opinions and give simple reasons. Translate simple sentences into language. Generally accurate in target language simple sentences. 	 WRITE Write short texts giving and seeking information and opinions, referring to the past or future as well as the present. Translate longer sentences into target language, including some grammar. Mostly accurate and meaning is clear with some minor errors.
