### New for 2019-2020

#### Teen Tech (9 UPPER ABILITY LEARNERS)

TeenTech is an award-winning event, where year 9 students from 30 schools from across Greater Manchester will join STEM professionals from many different industries for a lively "hands-on" day of experiments and challenges. It's an opportunity for students and teachers to learn more about careers and have their preconceptions about science and engineering changed forever.

Students move in small groups, led by an Industry Ambassador and their teacher through the Innovation Zone, Insight Exhibition and Challenge Zones. It's a powerful intervention just before students make GCSE subject choices, dispelling gender stereotypes and shifting perceptions of careers teenagers may have considered "difficult", "geeky" or "boring".

#### MISSION:HE Cohort of 12 Y11 Underachieving Boys

A 6 week programme designed to break down barriers and raise aspirations amongst young male students who are typically underrepresented in HE. The sessions combine information about post-16 pathways with team building, coaching, study skills and interactions with role-models and guest speakers.

#### Maths Club' Salford University

Sessions are designed to improve students' confidence, motivation and attainment in maths, helping them to prepare for their GCSE assessments (whether foundation or higher). Sessions can be tailored to focus on key curriculum 'problem' areas, for example algebra and fractions, and have challenge-based, practical and very interactive format- giving students the opportunity to explore difficult topics in a new and interesting way.

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#### BBC Bitesize Schools Tour

It's a really inspiring project that sees the BBC Bitesize team take to the road to deliver a series of 1 hour career sessions to secondary school children. The BBC will setup will a 'Question Time' style setup featuring a panel of 2-3 professionals from TV, Radio, Journalism, Sport, Gaming, PR, Music, Events and a whole variety of roles from within the creative industry, which will be hosted by an experienced Presenter. The aim is to offer insight into the world of work and shine a light on routes into and opportunities within a sector that many of the audience might not have considered.
