Examination Information

Coursework is complete in year 10 and 11 and is worth 60% of the overall mark. The external exam is complete in year 11 and is worth 40% of the overall mark.

Component 1: Exploring professional dance works. Written portfolio and classwork video footage.

Component 2: Developing skills and techniques in dance. Performing existing repertoire. Written evaluations to support exam video evidence taken in class, Progression portfolio.

Component 3: In January of year 11, the exam question is released and students will have 12 weeks to plan and prepare their exam piece. This is both written and practical work. The final practical exam for this component will take place over one day. Students will have 3 hours to complete 3 written assessments to accompany the practical element.
