1. You have the same seat for every exam.
2. You need to know where you are sitting before your exam
3. Your FT has a copy of the seating plan and they will be on display around school.
4. There will be equipment on your desk when you enter your exam - they must remain on your desk at the end of your exam

# Expectations of the exam

These exams are as close to the real thing as we can make them. Therefore you must abide by the expectation of an exam.

These are:

1. You must be in silence the moment you enter the exam hall
2. You must not communicate in any way whilst in the exam hall (the exception is asking an invigilator a question)
3. You must not have any electronic device on your person (this includes in pockets)
4. You must not have any revision material on your person (this includes pockets)
5. There will be a card on each desk with the letter T (for toilet) please raise this if you need the toilet and an invigilator will signal for you to leave the exam room with them
6. Bring the correct equipment to the exam (ie. Black pens, pencil, ruler, calculator)

# Logistics

## P1 - 2 exam

1. You will attend form as normal
2. Once you get your mark you will go straight to the canteen
3. Once in the canteen you will sit with your row on an allocated table
4. You will be escorted to the exam hall 1 row at a time
5. You will place your bag in a plastic bag
6. When you get to your desk you will place your bag under the table
7. You will not be able to access your bag again until you leave the exam hall
8. You will wait in silence for the exam to begin.

## P3-4 exam

1. When the bell sounds at the end of break you will go to the canteen and sit with your row on an allocated table
2. You will be escorted to the exam hall 1 row at a time
3. You will place your bag in a plastic bag
4. When you get to your desk you will place your bag under the table
5. You will not be able to access your bag again until you leave the exam hall
6. You will wait in silence for the exam to begin.

If you complete your exams away from the exam hall - you will go to your allocated room when you get your mark and at the end of break.

# Lessons

When you are not in exams:

1. You will be in a form bubble
2. Your form will be allocated a room for each lesson - this will be supervised by a member of staff
3. You will be told your room numbers for the day by your tutor and reminded of them at the end of the exam.
4. You will attend this lesson with your form
5. When in the lesson you will either complete a revision lesson or independent revision
6. You must bring in revision resources.
7. You will go home at 1.30 if you do not have a P5 exam
