## LEVEL 1

Course length	1 year
Entry requirements	4 GCSEs at grade 2/3 including English and maths at grade 2

## LEVEL 2

Course length	1 year
Entry requirements	4 GCSEs at grade 3 or above including English and maths at grade 3

## LEVEL 3

Course length	2 years
Entry requirements	5 GCSEs grades 9 – 4 including English and maths at grade 4
