## **COVID**

If you or a family member displays symptoms of COVID, please do not come in to school. You will need to isolate and be tested as per national guidance. If your child tests positive, please contact school by email on our dedicated email address covid@heslerton.n-yorks.sch.uk

This can be done at any time during the school day, evenings or weekends. Parents will be notified of bubbles being closed with messages on Class Dojo and on the school website. We hope that this will mean children do not need to have wasted journeys to school and families can have greater notice of any closures.

### **COVID IN SCHOOLS**

Following a large increase in Covid cases recently, NYCC have asked all schools to regularly remind parents of the following expectations:

- Please ensure that you maintain social distancing from others when dropping off and collecting your child from our school. Please follow any guidance issued by your child's school to help with this e.g. only one adult per family should enter school grounds to collect children.
- For those travelling by car we ask that you wait in your car until your specific drop off time. This will reduce the amount of people assembling in and around the school grounds and will help with social distancing.
- All parents/carers entering the school premises (and in other congested areas around school premises) should wear a face covering in addition to social distancing. This is an extra safeguard to reduce the transmission of the virus where social distancing cannot be maintained. Please note that this does not apply to those who are medically exempt.
- You must keep at least two metres apart from other parents/carers at all times. Where you are unable to do so, wear a face covering.
