POSADA


Several of our local Churches have introduced a Mexican tradition of Advent called Posada.


UNAUTHORISED LEAVE AND TERM-TIME HOLIDAYS

All term time holidays are classified as unauthorised leave under national rules commencing September 2024.

All leave without permission or proven reason is considered unauthorised leave by authorities. 10 sessions of unauthorised absence (a session is a half day) in any 10 weeks will result in a penalty notice being issued. Please come and speak to school should you have an issue with attendance.

PUNCTUALITY

All children can attend school from 8.30am. Those arriving after 8.55 when registers close are considered unauthorised by authorities. Arriving late 10 times in any 10 weeks will result in a penalty notice being issued. Please come and speak to school should you have an issue with getting to school on time. There are support systems in place to help those who struggle with punctuality.
