CRUCIAL CREW

Year 6 will be attending Crucial Crew in Scarborough on **Thursday, June 13th** during the morning. They will work through several emergency situations, learning to analyse risks and to deal with emergencies. If your child requires a booster seat, please ensure they bring it to school on the day. The children will need to wear trousers and sensible shoes, as they are active during the exercises. Some activities take place outside so each child will need a warm, waterproof coat, sun hat and sunscreen so we are prepared for the English summer!

If your child requires an inhaler please ensure this is with them. School carries County Insurance for all school trips. In case of emergency, please contact school.
