#### **SCARLET FEVER**

We have a confirmed case of Scarlet Fever in school. Scarlet Fever can be quite contagious so please remain vigilant.

Scarlet fever mostly affects young children. It's easily treated with antibiotics. The first signs of scarlet fever can be flulike symptoms, including a high temperature, a sore throat and swollen neck glands.

A rash appears later. It looks like small, raised bumps and starts on the chest and tummy, then spreads. The rash makes your skin feel rough, like sandpaper. On white skin the rash looks pink or red. On brown and black skin, it might be harder to see a change in colour, but you can still feel the rash and see the raised bumps. A white coating also appears on the tongue. This peels, leaving the tongue red, swollen and covered in little bumps (called "strawberry tongue"). The rash does not appear on the face, but the cheeks can look red.
