This week we have started developing our adjective use with a little help from the film 'The Way Back Home', all about a little boy exploring the world and the moon in his rocket. This led to lots of discussions, amazing adjectives which we then used to develop our extended noun phrases in our sentences. Next week we will carry on with the film and build up writing our character descriptions. In maths it was all about 3D shape this week, lots on investigations around the shape, which 2D shapes they are made from, which ones can we build with, as well as variation and looking at 3D shapes around us.

We also entered a very exciting competition... an 'Under the Sea' themed competition by the Sealife centre. We enjoyed researching what animals, plants and other things we would find at the bottom of the sea. We then used play doh to sculpt our scene, complete with sharks, sunken pirate ship, treasure, sting rays, crabs, octopuses, fish, turtles, sea horses and more!
