BADGER WOOD

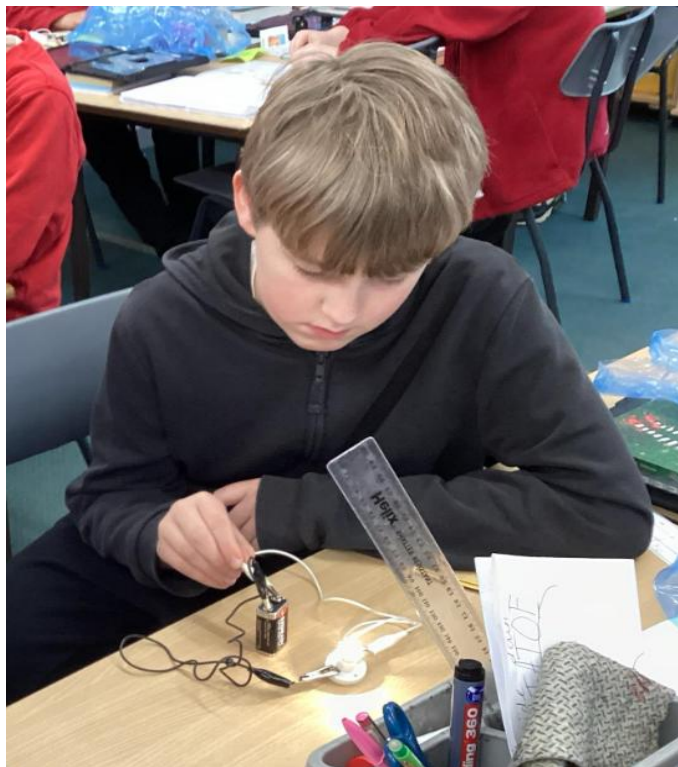
In PE this afternoon the children have worked in pairs to mirror each others movements with their body and streamer.

We have been investigating the effect of different voltages in Science.

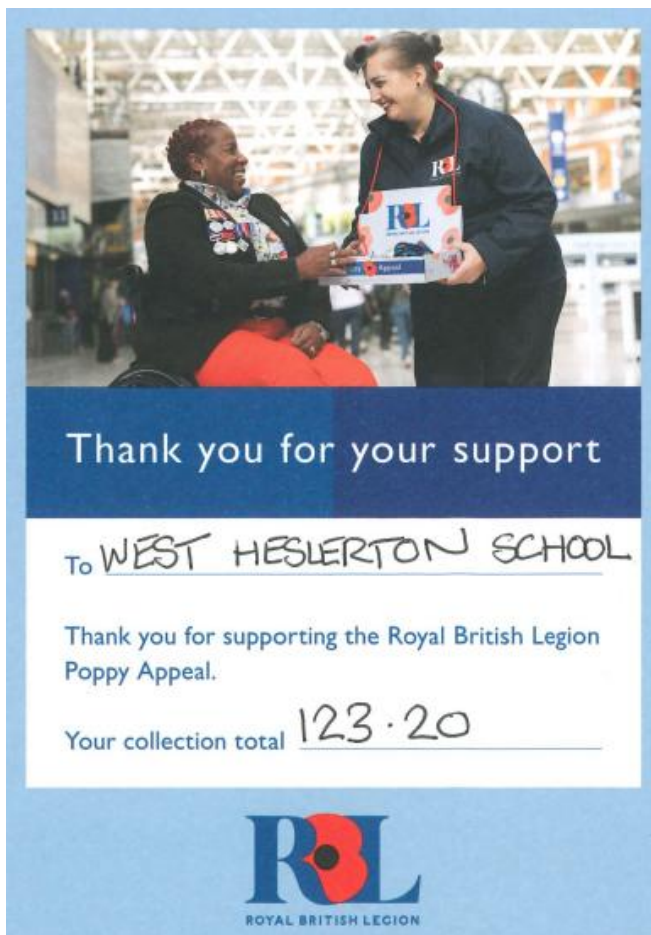


HOLIDAYS
