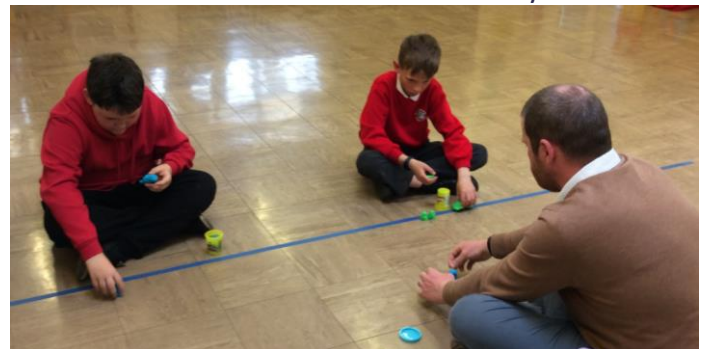
FARTHING WOOD
