SCHOOL

Attendance – we have been lenient during Covid times but we now need to focus upon punctuality. Pupils should arrive at school between 8.30 and 8.45am. Pupils arriving between 8.45 and 8.55am will be given a late mark. Those arriving after this time will be marked absent for the session unless a reason is given. Please find attached school attendance policy and an attendance record for your child so far this year.

Uniform - please would you check all clothing is your child's. There has been some muddling of uniform. If you find another child's clothing, please bring it to school after half term so that clothing can be returned to the correct child. Please ensure that all uniform is named.

Payments – please would you ensure that payment for dinners and after school club is paid in full by 9am on Friday of the week in which it is due. This saves reminders being written each week, thank you. We would encourage payment by ParentPay. If you require a login please ask at the office.

Dinners – school dinners for next half term will be £100, £92.50 for children in Keeper Wood, (due to the residential visit).

Clothing – all children need a coat in school every day please.

The class enjoyed hearing Michael Rosen tell his poem, "Chocolate Cake".




Practising our javelin and discus throwing skills, using quoits and beanbags

COVID

Should you have **any Covid test results**, please share these with us using covid@heslerton.n-yorks.sch.uk so that we can alert Health England and all families as soon as possible to any contact (within 48 hours) that has taken place. **Results still need to be reported during the school holidays to allow track and trace to take place.** Emails are checked daily, including weekends, to identify cases of children at school and home.

Pupils, staff and other adults must not come into the school for at least 10 days if:

- they have one or more coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms.
- a member of their household (including someone in their support bubble or childcare bubble if they have one) has coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms.
- they need to quarantine having recently visited countries outside the Common Travel Area.
- they have had a positive test.
