Payments

West Heslerton School is working towards becoming a cash free school by the end of 2021, in line with most other schools. From September, we will ask that payment for dinners, after school club, trips, swimming etc. are made using the online system Parent Pay. A login can be provided by school on request. Other forms of payment, such as uniform will gradually migrate to an online system.

P.E.

Independence

In order to develop and encourage independence, please send permission slips, consent forms etc. to school with your child. They will hand these to the class teacher to return to the school office.

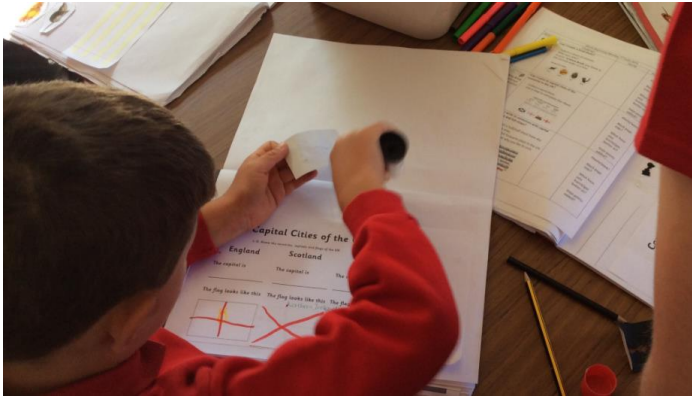
