## Sausage & Tomato Pasta

Bringing a taste of school lunches into your home

Serves 5



### Method

1. Cook the sausages in the oven or grill until fully cooked as per the packet instructions.
2. Fry off onions and garlic in a large pan until softened.
3. In a separate pan, boil the pasta until fully cooked and crisp to the bite. Drain carefully.
4. Add remaining ingredients (except sausages and cheese) to the onion and garlic and cook on low for 10 minutes.
5. Cut up your sausages and add to the sauce.
6. Add the cooked pasta to the sauce and mix. Carefully pour into an ovenproof dish.
7. Sprinkle with cheese and bake in a moderate oven until the top is golden.

### Ingredients

- 300g sausages
- 1 medium onion, finely diced
- 5ml vegetable oil
- 50g frozen mixed peppers
- 250g penne pasta
- 5g tomato puree
- 250g chopped tomatoes
- 1/2tsp mixed herbs
- 50g grated red cheddar
- 1/2tsp garlic puree
