SPORTS DAY

We have been asked a few questions about sports day following the exciting news that this could take place. Unfortunately, now the full details have been published and following on from the updated admin conference held on line yesterday the extent of the covid restrictions was clearly spelled out by Public Health and Health and Safety. We are unable to host sport day safely with parents this year due to various regulations including the 2m rule between households and the mixing of bubbles. MILK
