School Bubbles

Governors have agreed that all school bubbles and current Covid safety measures will remain in place until the end of term. Children have worked so hard this year and families need a break. School is responsible for contact tracking until mid August. By maintaining the current bubbles, should we be told of a positive case of Covid, only children in the affected class (or club) will need to self-isolate prior to the end of term or into the holidays.

Dates

Friday, July 16th -school performance finale Monday, July 19th – whole school sports afternoon, for pupils only, in class bubbles Thursday, July 22nd – Year 6 leavers' celebration day for the whole school. This will be socially distanced in bubbles and will include a bouncy castle assault course, golf tuition and class games outside.

Friday, July 23rd – school closes for the summer holidays at the usual time.

Swimming

Please will you return any outstanding swimming forms on Monday so that we can organise groups. Thank you.

Across the county there has been a recent rise in positive Covid cases in a number of schools. In some cases, due to the numbers of pupils and staff isolating, this has resulted in almost closing or closing the school for a period of time. We know how worrying this time is and how disruptive school closure can be to families. We are working with the DfE, Public Health England and NYCC to ensure we are following all guidance. The current Covid restrictions including bubbles will remain in place until the end of term to protect children, families and staff from this virus and to limit self-isolation as much as we can. We are hoping that the Government will send out advice about September before the end of term and will share this with you as soon as we are able.

Should you have **any Covid test results**, please share these with us using **covid@heslerton.nyorks.sch.uk** so that we can alert Health England and all families as soon as possible to any contact (within 48 hours) that has taken place. **Results still need to be reported during the school holidays to allow track and trace to take place**. Emails are checked daily, including weekends, to identify cases of children at school and home.

Pupils, staff and other adults must not come into the school for at least 10 days if:

• they have one or more <u>coronavirus (COVID-19)</u> <u>symptoms.</u>

• a member of their household (including someone in their <u>support bubble</u> or <u>childcare</u> <u>bubble</u> if they have one) has coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms.

• they need to <u>quarantine having recently visited</u> countries outside the green area

• they have had a positive test.
