SPACES AVAILABLE IN GYMNASTICS CLUB YEARS 1 to 3

There is a Gymnastics Club at West Heslerton CE School this half term for **5 weeks** for pupils in **Years 1-3**.

UNAUTHORISED LEAVE AND TERM-TIME HOLIDAYS

All term time holidays are classified as unauthorised leave. All leave without permission is considered unauthorised leave by authorities. 10 sessions of unauthorised absence (a session is a half day) in any 10 weeks will result in a penalty notice being issued. Please come and speak to school should you have an issue with attendance.

PUNCTUALITY

All children arriving after 8.55 when registers close are considered unauthorised by authorities. Arriving late 10 times in any 10 weeks will result in a penalty notice being issued. Please come and speak to school should you have an issue with getting to school on time. There are support systems in place to help those who struggle with punctuality.

Meals must be ordered by 9:30am. If not ordered by 9:30am please provide a packed lunch for your child.

INCLUSIVE CLASSROOMS

We are a highly inclusive school with Quality First Teaching for all children each day. This means that all children are taught and supported with a range of strategies that are part of their usual routine. These strategies are adapted to meet children's needs in class. Each week we will share with you an aspect of Quality First Teaching so that all parents and families are aware of the high quality provision at West Heslerton Primary School.

[Visual Timetables & Cues](#): Each class has a visual timetable. Visual timetables aid organization and can reduce anxiety. Symbols used are the same throughout the school to help children move to new classes.

YEAR 5 VISITS TO SECONDARY SCHOOLS

To help pupils to experience a secondary school day, both Malton School and Norton College will host a day this half term.

MALTON

All Year 5 students will visit Malton School on Tuesday 23rd June for the Year 5 Experience Day. The students will be experiencing THREE one-hour activities in Science, Performing Arts and Food/Design Technology. Session 1 10.15-11.15am Session 2 11.20-12.20pm Lunch 12.20-12.50pm Session 3 12.50-1.50pm. They will travel to Malton on Malton transport accompanied by Mrs Wardell. This transport will return them to school for the end of the school day. **Students will require a drink/snack and a packed lunch.** All other equipment required for the day will be provided. If your child is eligible for free school meals, a pack up can be provided. This should be ordered by **Thursday 11th June.**
