Are you a parent/carer (or grandparent) of a child with SEND? Do you sometimes feel overwhelmed with things being unfair? Are you passionate about inclusion and being part of positive change?

We at Dingley's Promise are passionate about inclusion and are currently working in your area to improve things for young children so that they can take part in early years provision (childminders, day nurseries, preschools, and school nurseries). We know all too well that many families with your children with SEND are not able to take up their full early years entitlements at the moment. We also understand the huge impact this can have. Our Comic Relief funded project is delivering training in your area to turn that issue around. We have 6000+ early years staff signed up across 21 areas taking part, and over 96% of those who complete it saying they can take more children with SEND as a result. We want to reach more!

We already have a small number of brilliant parent/carers who are helping to spread the word locally and are having a HUGE impact, Just knowing about the project and telling a few other people about it can help us to achieve our aims. They also tell us that being part of this project, linking up with other parents and connecting with us every now and then is helping them in the following ways;

- Being part of positive change

- Making connections, friendship, and peer support
