Choose our 2km route to The Sands and back or take a 5km option to Hairy Bob's skate park and back. The 10km route is the same as the 5km route... but you do it twice!


Registration is only £10 and under 16s are FREE - every participant also gets completely free entry to Sea Life Sanctuary for the day!
