BIG AMBITION SURVEY

The Children's Commissioner for England, Dame Rachel de Souza, has launched **The Big Ambition.** The Big Ambition aims to hear from children across England on what they think is important. The Children's Commissioner wants to take children's thoughts, opinions and ideas to decision-makers, to make sure that the Government hears young people's voices on what they think needs to be done to make children's lives better in England.

The Big Ambition is open to children and young people in England aged 0-18 years old. The survey would like to hear from children and young people aged from 6 to 18. Parents are also being encouraged to complete the survey for those who may need additional support or on behalf of younger children (under 6) to make sure the needs of early years children are represented too.

It takes around **10 minutes** to complete and can be completed on mobile phones, tablets, laptops and computers. Everything in the survey is anonymous. The survey asks for information about the person responding, the child's age, and what school they attend. The questions are slightly different depending on the age of the child answering, but, everyone is asked what they think the Government should do to make children's lives better.
