SCHOOL MEAL PRICE

We are very proud of our school meal offer. Children have a nutritious 2 course meal cooked from scratch on our school premises. The price of this is subsidised by school for all children. As the costs to us have recently gone up (staffing, energy costs, food costs) the governors have reluctantly put the price up per meal by 10 pence per meal per day. Meals will be subsidised by school by 23 pence per day for most meals and considerably more for those having free school meals and universal infant meals. School meals will therefore be charged at £3.20 per day from Monday 4th November. This still demonstrates great value for money.
