The whole school visited Scarborough for a Beach School Day. They visited the Lifeboat station in the morning and spent the afternoon exploring rock pools.























Badgers have explored the 7 continents and 5 oceans. They loved looking at maps and in the atlas to find out where they all were.

They have also entered a very exciting competition... an 'Under the Sea' themed competition run by the Sealife Centre so let's hope they did well.



The children in Keeper Wood and Farthing Wood have worked in teams to create their own Mount Everest and have written diary entries for their epic adventure up Mount Everest.

They have looked at the explorer Ernest Shackleton and his epic challenge to cross Antarctica. The children chose one of his crew members and followed their footsteps carefully. They wrote a letter of application for the job that he advertised in the newspaper.


The Badger Wood adventures with the Churches Conservation Trust have been published as an amazing book! ISBN 978-0-46-402457-6.
